JELGAVA PALACE AND THE FAMILY VAULT OF THE DUKES OF COURLAND 4

Visit the largest baroque palace in the Baltic States – the former residence of the Dukes of Courland, currently Latvia University of Life Sciences and Technologies, visit the museum of



Jelgava Palace and participate in entertainment programmes! You are also welcome to visit one of infrequent burial sites of ruling dynasties of the world – the vaults of the Dukes of Courland at Jelgava Palace, where you can see 30 sarcophagi and reconstructed burial costumes.

SIGHTSEEING TOWER AND WILD HORSES ON PILS ISLAND

Climb the 20 metres high sightseeing tower, from which you will be able to observe the regularly flooded alluvial meadows of Lielupe, a herd of wild horses and the panorama of the city! Book in advance and, accompanied by an environmental guide, take an island excursion by an off-road vehicle! PASTA ISLAND AND CHAMOTTE SCULPTURE PARK



Enjoy a day out on the Pasta island in any season! In the summertime you can relax on the beach or swim in the Lielupe river, play volleyball or take a trip around the island by boat, catamaran or SUP. It's a wonderful place for peaceful walks and bicycle rides all year round, and children love the nearby playgrounds. Skate and listen to wonderful music in the public skating rink — with ice skates in winter and roller skates in summer. The sculpture park consists of

more than 20 large- scale ceramic (chamotte) sculptures, in the southern part of the island – wooden sculptures. Not only is the Pasta island the site of the biggest city festivals, there is also a sand sculpture park in the summertime and an open air concert hall "Mītava" with various concerts. Pasta Island

LANGERVALDE FOREST

Visit the Lagervalde forest, a developed forest area with walking paths. The forest can be explored by various routes - the shortest trail is 800 metres, and the longest is 3 kilometres long. You will find wooden boardwalks and bridges along the trails, and the entrance is decorated with wooden animal sculptures. Langervalde Forest, main entrance from Rubeni Road.

VECPILSĒTAS STREET QUARTER AND ENVIRONMENTAL OBJECT "LAIKA RATS 100"

Explore the historical buildings of Jelgava- enjoy the atmosphere created by the 19th century wooden constructions and cobbled streets in the quarters of Old Town. In the 17th century, this section held the Dobele gate for entering the city. Not far from there you can take a look at the "Wheel of Time" created by sculptor Kārlis Īle, commemorating the centenary of Latvia, and find out more about the most important events in the history of Jelgava. The price of the Joint Admission Card is EUR 5. The price, if the tickets are bought separately – EUR 6.50.



During summertime, you can enjoy a boat ride on the Driksa and Lielupe river — the boats can accommodate from 7 to 40 guests per ride. The rides last from 30 minutes to an hour, during which you will discover the most beautiful scenery of Jelgava from water.


