

## Shortly about Jelgava

Jelgava is situated in the southern part of the Zemgale plain. The city is situated on the both banks of Lielupe River, with elevation from 0.0 to 6.0 m above the sea level. Jelgava is the fourth largest city in Latvia with population around  $66\,000$ .

Geographical location of the city is very favourable. Jelgava is the junction of railroads and railway lines leading in East-West and North-South directions. A modern Jelgava roundabout route was built in 1996; it joins Jelgava - Riga and Lithuania - Western Europe arterial roads.

Total territory of Jelgava is 60 km<sup>2</sup>, out of which:

- 2,34 km<sup>2</sup> are open waters
- 1,62 km<sup>2</sup> parks

## Coat of arms



Jelgava is the only city in Latvia that has the small State Emblem incorporated in the coat of arms of city. The first coat of arms - stag's head on a crimson background, and rights of the city were granted to Jelgava in 1573. However, now the coat of arms depicts head of elk on the purple field.

## Flag



The city flag was approved on the 28<sup>th</sup> of October, 1938.

It is divided in two equal parts: overhead is dark blue, but below red. The coat of arms of the city is placed in the middle of the flag.





## Budget income in 2005 (%)



## Budget spendings in 2005 (%)




## Budget spendings in 2006 (%)






## Gender structure in Jelgava City (%)






## Nationalities in Jelgava in the beginning of year (%)



# Inhabitants involved in sport activities from the year 2000 to the year 2004





## Public Gathering



## Migration balance in Latvian cities, 2004







## Number of children in pre-school establishments









# Children attending Jelgava City pre-school establishments, grouped by year of birth, school year 2005/06





## Number of pupils in comprehensive schools





# Number of form 12 graduates in Jelgava City, who continue their studies, %





Buildings ready for exploitation.


**In 2004** 45 individual houses with total area of 10 503  $\text{m}^2$ , as well as 13 shops with total area of 12 985  $\text{m}^2$  and 10 office premises with total area of 5 297  $\text{m}^2$  were put into operation.

413 construction permissions were issued, including 120 permissions for private housing construction, 16 - for shops and 2 - for office premises.

**In 2005** 54 individual dwelling houses with total area of 11 132  $\text{m}^2$ , house with 60 flats in 14a Asteru Street (total area - 4 648  $\text{m}^2$ ), house with 104 flats in 35 Satiksmes Street (total area - 7 949  $\text{m}^2$ ), as well as shops with total area of 20 853  $\text{m}^2$  and office premises with total area of 1 964  $\text{m}^2$  were put into operation.

552 construction permissions were issued, including permissions for construction of private housing, cafes and office premises. Construction permissions were also issued for the construction of dwelling houses in 12 Zirgu Street (58 flats) and 4 Karklu Street (70 flats).






# Registered unemployment rate in Latvia and Cities (%)



## Privatisation of flats in Jelgava, data on December 31, 2005







## Gross Domestic Product in Latvia and Cities, LVL per capita





# Non-financial investments in Latvia and Cities, LVL per capita




