









Age and gender structure of Jelgava residents at the beginning of 2025

The population of Jelgava and the factors influencing its changes in 2015-2024





Number of immigrants and emigrants in the 8 state cities in 2024




Number of remigrants* in Jelgava 2015-2024

The population of Jelgava by nationality*, 2015-2025 at the beginning of the year








The number of marriages concluded and divorces registered in Jelgava in 2024







The number of people working in Jelgava 2015.-2024. g.





Employed persons in Jelgava by place of residence in 2024





The number of working Jelgava inhabitants, incl. those working in Jelgava and Riga in 2014-2024. g.



Working Jelgava inhabitants in the distribution by workplace areas in 2024




Employees by employment status in Jelgava in 2024






Monthly average* gross salary of workers in 7 national cities in 2024, euro





Average monthly gross wages of employees in 7 state cities by sector, 2023-2024, euro








Unemployment rate (%) in Jelgava and Latvia 2018-2024



Unemployment rate, % in state cities 2022-2024




Number of registered unemployed and long-term unemployed in Jelgava 2017-2024.



Unemployment rate, % and number of unemployed in Jelgava in 2024 by month




Number and proportion of unemployed persons by duration of unemployment in Jelgava in 2024







Education level of the unemployed in Jelgava in 2024



Number of registered unemployed persons by age groups, target groups, and gender in Jelgava in 2024









The number and proportion of economically active companies in the market sector in Jelgava, by main types of activity in 2023













The amount of foreign investments accumulated in companies registered in Jelgava, mln. *euro* 2018-2024









Trends in the number of students in interest-based education 2020/2021 – 2024/2025 academic years






Number of students in Jelgava vocational education institutions in vocational education programs 2020/2021-2024/2025




Number of students enrolled in vocational sports education programmes from the 2020/2021 to 2024/2025 academic years





Number of students enrolled in vocational cultural education programmes from the 2020/2021 to 2024/2025 academic years





Number of students at the Latvia University of Life Sciences and Technologies from 2019 to 2024





Number of international students at the Latvia University of Life Sciences and Technologies from 2020 to 2024





Number of graduates at the Latvia University of Life Sciences and Technologies 2019-2024







Guaranteed minimum income benefit for a single person per year in the 7 state cities, in euro, 2022-2024




Housing benefit for a single person per year in the 7 state cities, in euro, 2022-2024








Number of outpatient healthcare and emergency medical care patients at Jelgava City Hospital







Statistics of road traffic accidents in Jelgava 2015-2024









Attendance at cultural events in Jelgava 2014-2024





Number of visitors to cultural and historical tourism sites of the Jelgava Municipality from 2022 to 2024








